PLAN AHEAD: Determine an offsite meeting location or check in procedure in the event of a building evacuation.

200 WEST MADISON Emergency Procedures

IN CASE OF A MEDICAL EMERGENCY:

- 1. Call the Chicago Fire Department at **911**. Give the building address 200 West Madison, the floor number, and where you are on the floor.
- 2. Call Building Security at 312-407-6410. Give the floor and exact location of where you are.

IF YOU DISCOVER SMOKE OR FIRE:

- 1. Call the Chicago Fire Department at **911**. Give the building address 200 West Madison, the floor number, and exact location of the smoke.
- 2. Call Building Security at 312-407-6410. Give the floor and exact location of the smoke.

IN THE EVENT OF SEVERE WEATHER/TORNADO:

- 1. Move away from exterior windows, and prepare to shelter in place. Listen for instruction from building management.
- 2. Proceed to the building's internal stairwells to take shelter in place.

DURING AN EVACUATION:

- 1. Stay CALM!
- 2. Listen to the orders given by building management and the emergency evacuation team members.
- 3. Use the stairwells. **Do not** use the elevators.
- 4. In case of a fire, feel any door with the back of your hand. Do not open any doors that are too hot to touch.
- 5. Close all doors behind you to help contain fire and smoke. Do not lock the doors.
- 6. If smoke is present, stay as close to the floor as possible.

IF ALL ESCAPE ROUTES ARE BLOCKED:

- 1. Move as far away from the fire as possible; close all doors between you and the fire.
- Stuff clothing or other material around ventilation ducts and cracks in doors to prevent smoke from penetrating the room.
- 3. **Call 911** and give the building address 200 West Madison, the floor number you are on, and where on the floor you are.

PERSONS WHO REQUIRE RESCUE ASSISTANCE

- 1. Wait by the Stairwell Entrance for Assistance.
- 2. When everyone has left the floor, enter the stairwell with the Evacuation Assistant.
- 3. The Evacuation Assistant will advise the Floor Warden if further rescue assistance is needed from the Fire Department or Building Staff.
- 4. Building Staff or a Firefighter will arrive to provide rescue assistance when alerted by the Floor Warden.
